Proceedings

The Meeting of the Anti-Ragging Committee was held on 18.09.2025 under the chairmanship of the Principal.

The Chairperson welcomed all the members and emphasized the Institution's commitment to maintaining a **safe, inclusive, respectful and completely ragging-free environment** for all students.

The following matters were discussed and decisions were taken:

1. Previous Minutes and Action Taken Report: Previous minutes were confirmed and the Action Taken Report was reviewed.

The Committee reviewed its constitution and the responsibilities of its members for the Academic Year 2025-2026. Members were advised to remain vigilant and discharge their assigned responsibilities effectively.

2. Awareness and Sensitization: Awareness activities were reviewed and regular programmes for newly admitted and continuing students were recommended. The Committee reviewed the applicable provisions relating to the prevention and prohibition of ragging. It was reiterated that ragging in any form is strictly prohibited and that the Institution follows a **zero-tolerance policy**.

3. Counselling and Reporting: Regular mentoring and accessible reporting mechanisms were emphasized.

The Committee decided to conduct Anti-Ragging awareness and sensitization programmes, particularly for newly admitted students. Students shall be informed about the prohibition of ragging, consequences of misconduct and available reporting mechanisms.

4. Squad and Inspections: The Squad was reviewed and periodic and surprise inspections were continued.

The Committee discussed the collection and proper maintenance of Anti-Ragging undertakings/declarations from students and parents, wherever applicable. The concerned staffs were instructed to maintain the records systematically.

5. Monitoring Arrangements: Vulnerable areas were reviewed and continuous vigilance was directed.

The Committee reviewed the role of the Anti-Ragging Squad and decided to undertake regular and surprise inspections of vulnerable areas.

6. Records and Undertakings: Undertakings, registers and documentary evidence were reviewed and systematic maintenance was instructed.

The Committee identified the need for continued vigilance in classrooms, corridors, canteen, hostel premises, transport areas and other student gathering points, wherever applicable.

7. Information and Helpline: Anti-Ragging information and reporting contacts were directed to remain prominently displayed.

The Committee resolved to ensure that Anti-Ragging notices, awareness material, reporting mechanisms and helpline/contact information are prominently displayed and communicated to students.

8. Complaints and Incidents: The complaint register and reports were reviewed. No complaint or incident of ragging was reported during the academic year as on the date of the meeting.

The Committee emphasized regular interaction between faculty mentors and students. Students shall be encouraged to report any concern without fear.

9. Effectiveness of Measures: Awareness, counselling, monitoring, inspections and reporting arrangements were found satisfactory.

The Anti-Ragging complaint register and available reports were reviewed.

The Committee unanimously recorded that no complaint or incident of ragging has been reported at Lingaraj Appa Engineering College, Gornalli, as on the date of the meeting.

10. Recommendations: Continued awareness, monitoring, counselling, documentation and prompt action on complaints were recommended.

The Committee resolved to:

- Conduct regular Anti-Ragging awareness programmes.
- Maintain continuous vigilance in vulnerable areas.
- Conduct periodic/surprise inspections.
- Strengthen student counselling and mentoring.
- Maintain all Anti-Ragging records properly.
- Ensure easy access to reporting mechanisms.
- Take prompt action if any complaint or information regarding ragging is received.



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11. Final Resolution: The Committee resolved to continue the zero-tolerance policy and strengthen preventive measures wherever necessary.

After detailed deliberation, the Committee unanimously resolved to **continue the zero-tolerance policy towards ragging** and implement all necessary preventive measures throughout the academic year.

There being no other matter for discussion, the meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chairperson.

The Meeting of the Anti-Ragging Committee was held on 27.03.2026 under the chairmanship of the Principal.

The Chairperson welcomed the members and stated that the purpose of the meeting was to review the implementation of preventive measures and assess the overall status of Anti-Ragging activities during the academic year.

1. Confirmation of Previous Minutes

The minutes of the First Meeting were placed before the Committee. After review, the minutes were **confirmed and approved**.

2. Review of Action Taken

The Committee reviewed the Action Taken Report relating to the decisions taken during the First Meeting. The Committee noted that the planned preventive measures had been implemented satisfactorily.

3. Awareness and Sensitization Programmes

The Committee reviewed the Anti-Ragging awareness and sensitization activities conducted during the academic year.

The Committee observed that students had been sensitized regarding the prohibition of ragging, its consequences and the mechanisms available for reporting concerns.

4. Student Counselling and Mentoring

The Committee reviewed the counselling and mentoring activities. Members emphasized the importance of maintaining regular interaction with students and encouraging them to report any concerns promptly.

5. Anti-Ragging Squad and Monitoring

The Committee reviewed the monitoring activities and inspection/surprise visit arrangements of the Anti-Ragging Squad.

The Committee decided that vigilance shall continue in all vulnerable areas to prevent any possibility of ragging.

6. Anti-Ragging Undertakings and Records

The Committee reviewed the status of Anti-Ragging undertakings/declarations and related documentation. The concerned staffs were advised to keep all records complete, updated and readily available for institutional compliance.

7. Display and Communication of Anti-Ragging Information

The Committee reviewed the display of Anti-Ragging notices and awareness material, including reporting and helpline information. The Committee resolved to continue regular dissemination of such information.

8. Review of Complaints and Incidents

The Committee reviewed the Anti-Ragging complaint register and reports available with the Institution.

The Committee unanimously recorded that no complaint, case or incident of ragging has been reported at Lingaraj Appa Engineering College, Gornalli, during the academic year

The Committee noted with satisfaction that the Institution continued to maintain a peaceful, disciplined and ragging-free academic environment.

9. Effectiveness of Preventive Measures

The Committee reviewed the effectiveness of the measures implemented during the academic year, including awareness programmes, counselling, monitoring, inspections and dissemination of Anti-Ragging information.

The Committee found the preventive measures to be satisfactory and recommended their continuation and further strengthening.
