

IMPORTANT DECISIONS OF THE GOVERNING COUNCIL

Some of the important decisions taken by the Governing Council of **Lingaraj Appa Engineering College, Bidar** in its meetings are as under:

24th Governing Council Meeting held on 19th October 2022.

Resolution No. 24.7

The Governing Council resolved to approve the increase in intake of the **B.E. Computer Science and Engineering programme from 54 seats to 120 seats**, considering the increasing demand for CSE admissions, availability of qualified faculty members, laboratory facilities, infrastructure and placement opportunities.

Resolution No. 24.8

The Governing Council resolved to approve the increase in intake of the **MBA programme from 54 seats to 60 seats**, considering the growing demand for management education and availability of faculty members, classrooms, infrastructure and placement support.

Resolution No. 24.9

The Governing Council resolved to approve the **reduction in intake of the Civil Engineering programme from 60 seats to 30 seats and the Mechanical Engineering programme from 60 seats to 30 seats**, considering the recent admission trends, utilization of available infrastructure and overall academic viability of the programmes.

26th Governing Council Meeting held on 12th December 2023.

Resolution No. 26.4

The Governing Council resolved to approve the proposal to **apply for establishment and recognition of a Research Centre in the Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE) Department**, as per the norms and guidelines of the University, with a view to strengthening research activities, promoting innovation, encouraging funded research projects and enhancing the academic and research profile of the Institution.

Resolution No. 26.5

The Governing Council resolved to approve the proposal to **apply for establishment of a Research Centre in the Department of MBA**, as per the norms and guidelines of the University, with a view to strengthening research activities, academic development, consultancy, innovation and research culture in the Institution.

28th Governing Council Meeting held on 24th June 2024.

Resolution No. 28.3

The Governing Council resolved to approve the **increase in intake of the MBA programme from 60 seats to 90 seats**, considering the growing demand for management education, admission trends and availability of qualified faculty members, classrooms, library resources, infrastructure facilities and placement support.

Resolution No. 28.4

The Governing Council resolved to approve the proposal to **start a new undergraduate programme in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (AIML)**, considering the growing demand for emerging technologies, industry requirements and career opportunities, subject to approval from the concerned statutory authorities and fulfillment of AICTE and University norms.

29th Governing Council Meeting held on 05th November 2024.**Resolution No. 29.7**

The Governing Council resolved to approve the proposal to **apply for recognition under Section 2(f) of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act**, and further resolved to initiate the necessary process for applying for **2(f) status from the University Grants Commission (UGC)** as per the prescribed norms and guidelines.

31st Governing Council Meeting held on 09th September 2025.**Resolution No. 31.6**

The Governing Council resolved to approve the **correction in the name of the Trust** in institutional and statutory records from **“Sharnbasveshwara Vidya Vardhak Sangha”** to **“Sharanabasaweshwar Vidya Vardhak Sangha”**, as per the relevant records and supporting documents.

Resolution No. 31.7

The Governing Council resolved to approve the **change in nomenclature of the M.Tech programme in AICTE records** from **“VLSI and Embedded System Design”** to **“VLSI Design and Embedded Systems”**, in accordance with the existing VTU records and applicable guidelines.

Resolution No. 31.8

The Governing Council resolved to approve the **change in the name of the Institution** from **“LINGARAJAPPA ENGINEERING COLLEGE”** to **“LINGARAJ APPA ENGINEERING COLLEGE”**, as per the prescribed norms and guidelines of the concerned statutory authorities.

Resolution No. 31.9

The Governing Council resolved to approve the proposal to **apply for NBA accreditation for the Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE) Department**, considering the preparedness of the department with respect to faculty qualifications, laboratory facilities, infrastructure, academic performance, student outcomes and compliance with NBA norms and guidelines.

The Governing Council resolved to approve the **delegation of financial powers to various heads** for effective administrative and financial management and also approved the provision of **Seed Money to faculty members to promote research activities**, subject to institutional norms and submission of relevant supporting documents.
