Proceedings:

1. Approval for Appointment of New Staff Members

The Governing body reviewed the requirement of additional teaching and non-teaching staff for effective academic and administrative functioning and approved the appointment of new staff members as per institutional norms and recommendations of the selection committee.

2. Approval for Increment and Promotion for existing Staff members.

After evaluating the performance, experience, and eligibility criteria of staff members, the Governing body approved 10% to 20% increment to all the staff members based on the performance and promotion to the eligible staff members.

3. Analysis of BE, M.Tech and MBA Results

The Governing body reviewed the academic results of BE, M.Tech and MBA programs in detail. The results were analysed based on key performance indicators such as overall pass percentage, number of students securing distinctions, first class and second class as well as subject wise performance across all programs.

After the detailed discussion the governing body emphasized the need for continuous academic monitoring and suggested measures such as remedial classes, mentoring and additional academic support to improve students outcomes and maintain academic standards.
