The Governing body meeting of Lingaraj Appa Engineering College, Bidar, held on 24/06/2024, Monday 11.00 AM

Proceedings:

1. Approval for Appointment of New Staff Members

The Governing Body reviewed the requirement for appointment of additional teaching and non-teaching staff members for the effective conduct of academic, administrative, and institutional activities. The department-wise staff requirements, workload distribution, student strength, and institutional needs were examined in detail.

After thorough discussion and evaluation, the Governing Body approved the appointment of new teaching and non-teaching staff members as per institutional requirements and recommendations of the selection committee.

2. Approval of Promotion and Increment of staff members

After evaluating the performance, experience, qualifications, and eligibility criteria of the staff members, the Governing Body approved an increment ranging from 10% to 20% for all the staff members based on their performance and institutional contribution.

The Governing Body also approved promotions for eligible staff members as per institutional norms and applicable regulations.

Further, considering the departmental requirements and institutional needs, the Governing Body approved a special increment for the staff members of the Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) department.

3. Approval for Increase in Intake from Existing 60 to 90 in MBA Program

The Governing Body discussed the proposal for increase in intake of the MBA program from the existing 60 seats to 90 seats considering the growing demand for management education, admission trends, and availability of institutional facilities. The availability of qualified faculty members, classrooms, library resources, infrastructure facilities, and placement support were reviewed in detail.

After thorough discussion and evaluation, the Governing Body approved the proposal for increase in intake of the MBA program from 60 to 90 seats.

4. Approval to Start New Course in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (AIML)

The Governing Body discussed the proposal for starting a new undergraduate program in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (AIML) considering the growing demand for emerging technologies, industry requirements, and career opportunities in the field of artificial intelligence and data-driven applications. The availability of infrastructure facilities, laboratory resources, qualified faculty members, and academic preparedness for offering the program were reviewed in detail.

After thorough discussion and evaluation, the Governing Body approved the proposal to start the new course in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (AIML), subject to approval from the concerned statutory authorities and fulfillment of AICTE and university norms.

The Governing Body further expressed that the introduction of the AIML program would enhance academic opportunities for students and strengthen the institution's position in emerging technological domains.
